4TH WEYMOUTH TOURING WEEK Sat May 19th — Sat May 26th 2012

The Dorset Section of the VMCC invite you to come and ride with us, in and around the beautiful Dorset countryside. The Weymouth Touring Week provides 6 days of approx 100 miles a day of relaxed riding, visiting places of interest stopping for coffee and lunch en route. Incorporating the long established 45th Weymouth Run it has become a major event for riders of classic machines.

The event is based at Bagwell Farm Touring Park, Chickerell, DT3 4EA, which is on the B3157 approximately 2 miles west of Weymouth. The rally field is exclusive to the event and we have full access to the toilets & shower block on the campsite approx 200yds away. Pitches are available for caravans/camper vans and tents, we will locate tents as close to the facilities as possible.

Camping fees for a unit for 2 people are £78.00 for a standard pitch and £96.00 for a pitch with electric hook up (pitches with an electric hook up are limited to 50 places) The campsite is open from Friday 18th through to Monday 28th for those requiring a more leisurely arrival and departure. Concessionary camping rates apply in respect of these extra nights.

Alternatively riders might prefer to make their own arrangements for accommodation at one of the numerous B&B's or hotels in the Weymouth area.

The daily runs, including the Weymouth Run, start from the campsite, with signing-on in the marquee 9-10am. Rides will be of approximately 100 miles and riders will be free to set their own pace, stopping as they wish to enjoy the scenery, or at suggested refreshment stops. Route sheets are issued each day and we would suggest a route sheet holder plus a speedo with a trip (or bicycle computer) would be an advantage. After the days riding you will be able to relax and enjoy the varied programme of evening entertainment provided in the marquee.

Entries are limited to 150 machines and close on 1st April or earlier if maximum number is reached. The entry fee covers participation in all of the runs, the evening receptions/entertainment in the marquee and free hog roast. A separate entry fee is payable for accompanying adults/passenger to cover evening entertainment etc. Additional fees such as museum admission etc. are the responsibility of the entrants, although at most places we have negotiated a discounted rate or have included them in the entry fee.

When you arrive on Friday 18th or Saturday 19th Please register at camp marquee where you will receive information pack and riding number, entrants staying in B&B are requested to do this also.
