

SOUTH WALES SECTION OF THE VMCC

WELSH DRAGON TOUR 2010

30th July/1st August 2010

For the eighteenth time the South Wales Section of the VMCC will hold a non-competitive Tour of Wales for solo motorcycles, sidecars and three-wheelers manufactured before the 1st January 1986. Please note this date will be strictly enforced.

The event is based at the Llandovery College as it was last year. The accommodation is as would be expected from a College with most rooms being singles and having a wash hand basin. There are a few double rooms but all have single beds and these will be allocated on a first come first served basis, we'll do our best to accommodate everyone as to their requests.

All meals at the college will be taken in the refectory and are on a self-service basis. If you have any dietary requirements then please let us know with a note on the entry form. We will have the use of the College Sixth Form Room and Bar for the Friday and Saturday evenings. The accommodation at the college will include the following meals: -

Dinner, Bed and Breakfast	Friday 30th July
Dinner, Bed and Breakfast	Saturday 31st July
Lunch	Sunday 1st Aug

Friday's evening meal will be available between 7.00pm and 8.00pm

The Saturday morning run commences between 9.30am and 10.00am and heads east then eastwards for a coffee stop at Hundred House. The run then continues northeast to Montgomery where we will take lunch, having covered some 88 miles or so. For the afternoon, the route heads southwest to Rhayader for a stop before returning to the college after covering another 70 miles.

The Sunday morning route of 38 miles will include a coffee stop at the Old School house in Defynnog before we return to the college for the last time for Sunday lunch and the dispersal of the event.

There is no problem with being able to park vehicles and trailers on the college campus for the weekend.

Again you will travel through some of the most beautiful countryside that Wales has to offer and it should be noted that the time schedule of the event is not too strenuous and allows you to indulge in some of the views which, I am sure, most people will enjoy and may not have seen before. Some of the roads we have travelled in the past and some are ones that you will not have ridden on before. The total distance to be covered is around 195 miles for the weekend. There is a limit of 85 persons on the accommodation and entries will be taken on a first come first served basis.

The cost, which includes overnight accommodation, all meals and refreshments for the whole weekend at each of the stops, plus a commemorative item, is **£81 per person**. Entries will close on the **12th July 2010** due to the need to finalise the accommodation requirements. It is important that we have an early entry from you.
